ON TRANSIT



Many transportation agencies are offering discounted fares in September and beyond to welcome commuters returning to their offices. TMASF Connects has developed this resource sheet, gathering information on transportation agencies that are currently offering fare discounts.

**Please note that these are not actual coupons.



CLIPPER START PROGRAM

Clipper announced the launch of an 18-month pilot of their <u>START</u> program in mid-July 2020, which would offer fare discounts on certain transit services for low-income adults between the ages of 19 and 64. Adults with an annual household income of no more than twice the federal poverty level (about \$52,400 for a family of four) are eligible for the Clipper START program.

50% fare discounts are offered on Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit and Ferry, Marin Transit, Muni, Samtrans, SF Bay Ferry, and SMART. 20% fare discounts are offered on AC Transit, BART, County Connection, Fairfield and Suisun Transit (FAST), Napa VINE, Petaluma Transit, Santa Rosa Citybus, Soltrans, Sonoma County Transit, Tri Delta Transit, Union City Transit, Vacaville City Coach, WestCAT, and Wheels.



BART is offering 50% off all BART fares on Clipper for the month of September 2021 to welcome riders back to the system. This promotion will apply concurrently with other Clipper discounts, granting an additional 50% off already discounted Clipper cards and fares such as Youth, Senior, ETC, Clipper START, and Gator Passes.

SFMTA/MUNI

As of Sunday, August 15th, 2021, **the Free Muni Program will be available to all youth 18 years of age and under.** All youth 18 years and under will be able to ride Muni regardless of financial status or verification, and without proof of payment. Cable Car access will still require the use of a valid pass (loaded onto a Clipper card).



<u>AC TRANSIT</u>

AC Transit is providing free rides every Friday in the month of September 2021 with Fare-Free Fridays. Riders can board without fare payment from 12am to 11:59pm on September 3rd, 10th, 17th, and 24th.

CALTRAIN

Caltrain is welcoming commuters back to transit with 50% off all fares for the month of September 2021. This includes September Monthly Passes, Day Passes, One-Way tickets, and Zone Upgrades. Youth and Senior fares are also eligible for discounts.

SF BAY FERRY

As of Thursday, July 1st, 2021, fares will be lowered for a period of one year to incentivize a return of commuters to ferry service.
