Here are a few common sources of Renewable Energy:

- **Solar Energy**: energy from the sun's light and heat
- **Wind Energy**: energy of moving air
- **Geothermal Energy**: accessible thermal energy from Earth's interior
- **Ocean Energy**: kinetic and thermal energy of seawater
